A circular walk around Llyn Maelog Lake and Traeth Llydan Beach. Mainly flat with some minor rocky outcrops which makes for a pleasant walk of 60/90 minutes.

1 START TO END OF BOARDWALK

From the Car Park, join the A4080 and walk left until you see the footpath sign, continue along the boardwalk. Cross the footbridge and follow the boardwalk path between the metal fence and the reeds on your right. Continue along this path to where the boardwalk ends at the lake side.

2 END OF BOARDWALK TO STEPS

At the end of the boardwalk you will see the small island where you will always see a variety of birds. Follow the path towards the house with a kissing gate and keep the red brick wall on your left. Ahead of you are the steps.

3 STEPS TO KISSING GATE

Climb up the steps to the next field and

the rocky outcrop with the sign indicating the wildlife conservation area. The path now follows the line of the bracken through the fields in the direction of the caravans and through a kissing gate with a sign showing David Bellamy Conservation Gold Award. Follow the way marker on the lower side of the gate bearing right along the lake side, not over the stile towards the caravan site.

4 KISSING GATE TO FOOTBRIDGE OVER STREAM

Walk between the rock outcrops and follow the yellow marker posts through another kissing gate and down to the lake side passing the rocks on your right and onto the footbridge at the furthest point of the lake.

5 FOOTBRIDGE OVER STREAM TO KISSING GATE

The path now follows the easterly side of the lake. Follow the path at the lake side with the gorse bushes on your left to reach the rocky outcrops and bear left to a kissing gate.

6 KISSING GATE TO START OF LANE

Pass through a further two kissing gates with way markers showing the path. The path then joins a dirt lane. Turn right at this lane.

7 START OF LANE TO POST BOX

Walk along the lane past houses on your left until you reach the main road. Turn right at the main road A4080. If you wished to shorten the walk then you could return to the car park along this road. To continue turn left at the small post box.

8 POST BOX TO WAY MARKER

Walk down the public footpath but be aware of vehicles travelling to and from the beach area. Follow this tarmac lane and continue on it as it bends to the right behind the houses.

9 WAY MARKER TO START OF BEACH

At the end of the lane, by the last house, follow a way marker over the sand turning left to reach the beach.

10 START OF BEACH TO RIVER

Turn right along the beach. The dunes on your right provide excellent areas for picnics and shelter from the wind. A clean flat beach is ideal for beach combing or metal detecting. Walk along the Traeth Llydan beach towards Rhosneigr to reach the river which flows from the Llyn Maelog Lake to the sea.

11 RIVER TO END

Turn right along the river bank and cross a footbridge to the picnic area. Follow the path towards the houses and turn right at the wall to return to your start point.

When venturing into the countryside, wear adequate footwear and take a waterproof. Follow the Countryside Code and respect other countryside users and wildlife. If walking with a dog, keep under close control (preferably on a lead) and take great care not to disturb livestock. Remember to check the weather forecast before you set off.
